## RESIDENT PHYSICIAN INTERNAL MEDICINE:

- My job includes doing an outpatient clinic, providing over 80 consultations per day due to the high flow of patients.
- Taking patient's history, doing physical examinations, ordering investigations, and preparing treatment plans.
- Management of medical ailments including but not limited to hypertension, diabetes, COPD, pneumonia, liver diseases, GI disorders, Autoimmune diseases, all diseases related to internal medicine.
- Management of infectious diseases including endemics, COVID-19, malaria, typhoid, TB, Dengue, meningitis and encephalitis.
- My job also includes doing ward duties, and preparing and updating charts of admitted patients.
- Doing morning and evening ward rounds with consultants, discussing cases, and planning treatment.
- Performing procedures inward like passing NG tub, intubation, urinary catheterization, LP, Pleural and ascetic tap.
- I was responsible for my patient's investigations, treatment, referrals, discharge and follow-up management.
- Counseling of patients and their families about health issues.
- My duties also include supervision of the internal medicine team in the absence of a consultant, assigning duties, and teaching junior doctors.
- Participating in weekly teaching seminars.
- Reviewing and presenting current literature related to patient care.

## RESIDENT PHYSICIAN INTENSIVE CARE UNIT:

- I performed duties in well well-equipped 30 bedded ICU and dealt with patients of different disciplines under the supervision of intensivists and ICU consultants.
- Care of all patients in ICU in conjunction with surgical and medical attending physicians.
- Provide continuous vigilant care, early intervention, and ongoing care.
- Perform critical care procedures like, CVP line insertion, arterial line insertion, endotracheal intubation, LP, pleural tapping, and ascetic tap independently.
- Respond to all cardiac and respiratory arrests in the ICU according to ACLS BLS guidelines.
- Attend ICU committee meetings and various seminars
- Perform and document subsequent evaluations of all the patients in the ICU daily.
- Breaking bad news and counseling.

## RESIDENT PHYSICIAN EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT:

- Performed duties in ED, and consulted over 100 patients per day.
- Management of patients with acute medical illnesses, exacerbations, and poisoning.
- Participated in all aspects of emergency care in collaboration with ED consultants.
