DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES IN NEONATAL ICU

Assess, plan and implement care based on patients' needs and evaluate the nursing care rendered. • Prompt monitoring of critically ill patients. • Care of preterm babies. • Initiate C.P.R during cardio pulmonary arrest. • Taking care of patients on ventilators. • Accurate documentation. • Perform IV cannulation, IV administration and blood transfusion. • Independent nursing action including insertion of Nasogastric tube, Foley catheter, blood sample collection, chest physiotherapy, wound dressing etc. • Receiving babies from Labour room, emergency department & OT. • Provide emergency care and medicines according to the conditions of the baby. • Frequent observation of colour of the baby, position of ET tube, Patency of IV cannula. • Insertion of IV cannula and collection of blood samples. • Assist physicians for procedures like endotracheal intubation, lumbar puncture, Arterial line insertion, exchange transfusion, umbilical vessel catheterization etc. • Provide health teaching and psychological support to the family members. • Preparation of reports and updating of records. • Receiving and handling over reports to the head nurse. • Setting up of ICU equipments, such as cardiac monitor, ventilator, defibrillator. • Checking vital signs. • Arranging for nutrition. Feeding the baby orogastric / nasogastric / orally. Assist in breast feeding. • Maintaining stock. • Empty chest tube drainage bottles. • Weaning from ventilator and extubation. • Doing ABG investigations. • Stoma care. • Tracheostomy care and suctioning. • Assisting with PICC line insertion. • Physiotherapy. • Assisting with ECHO, Head ultrasound, USG, Laser (ROP treatment). • Assisting with Bronchoscopy, OGD scopy.
